Using either the Bible or the writings of Ellen G. White as your source, you will find that mission work—seeking the lost in unworked fields—is a calling for every follower of Christ. Whether personally working in the vineyard or supporting those who do, all can play a part in supporting the work in the mission field.

Being a recipient of the Steps to Life newsletter, you have undoubtedly read of the many mission projects undertaken by this ministry in fulfilling this mandate.

Pastor Domingo Nunez our Director of Outreach for the ministry, has spent countless days and traveled many thousands of miles nurturing and training workers and establishing churches according to the New Testament gospel order. As a result of his efforts, funded

entirely by your donations, the work in that portion of the Lord’s vineyard, touched by his efforts on your behalf, has expanded exponentially.

Churches, mission headquarters, evangelistic efforts, Bible correspondence schools, prison ministries, prophecy and health seminars, publishing programs, and training centers have been established in Ghana, Kenya, Zambia, Malawi, Mozambique, Nigeria, Mexico, Colombia, and Bolivia. Important points of contact and field workers have been sponsored in India, the Philippines, Brazil, and Panama.

Printing and publishing operations have been funded allowing the spread of the three angels’ messages in previously unreached areas, often in the local languages, a resource that heretofore has been unavailable.

Except for ministers’ and Bible workers’ salaries or evangelistic expenses, all these mission projects are funded from our Mission fund. For the past five years,

faithful and dedicated workers have caused the expansion of the work to such an extent that the ministry has funded projects and workers at a level that has exceeded the income to our Mission fund by well more than half a million dollars.

Establishing this work has consumed the majority of this amount, but on-going operating and upkeep expenses continue to draw on this funding source, which is now overdrawn.

While it might seem appropriate to cease these activities until the mission fund is replenished, we cannot let these newly established efforts “die on the vine.” Thus, we appeal to you to help us in our efforts to continue encouraging and supporting the growth in these portions of the vineyard.

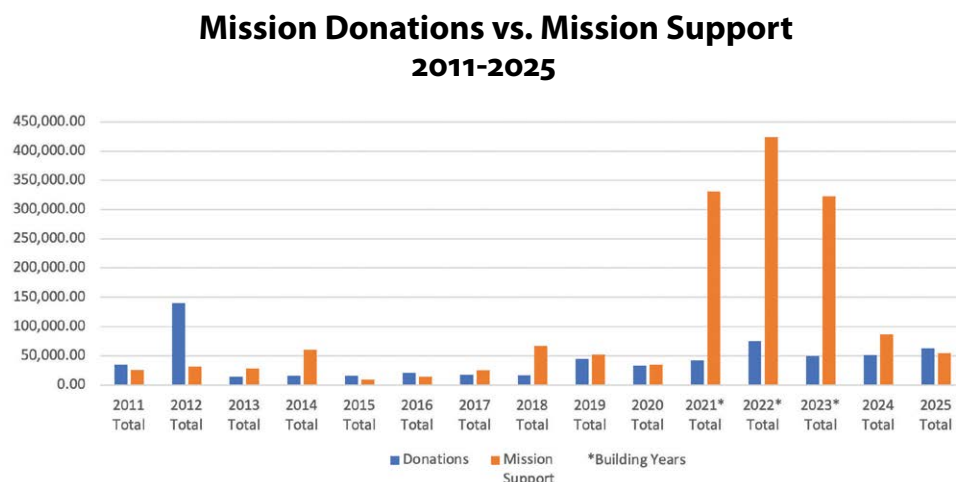
The signs of the time show more and more clearly each day that the coming of our Saviour is rapidly approaching. Please continue to help us as we strive to reach as many souls as possible in as many areas as possible.

To assist Steps to Life in our continuing efforts to spread the three angels’ messages around the world, please designate the amount of your total donation that you want to go to the Mission fund as *Missions*.

We would appreciate your prayers for us as we try to recover from this indebtedness in our Mission fund. Somebody might question how we can keep operating. The reason we can keep operating with sufficient cash flow is because we use a fund accounting system. Monies donated to Steps to Life are placed in several different funds. Because of the many projects Steps to Life is involved in, we have over 30 different funds. These are three of the major ones:

Non-Tithe Fund

If your donation is not labeled as tithe or not designated for the Mission fund or a specific mission project, it will go



into our general operating fund and will be used to pay our office building monthly expenses—maintenance, utilities, insurance, and so forth. The general fund also covers wages for ministry staff. Our monthly receipts from non-tithe donations sometimes pays all of these expenses with money left over and other months these donations are less than our expenses.

Tithe Fund

This fund has a goodly reserve of cash in it from Tithe donations which are used to pay the salaries and evangelistic expenses of the ministry’s ministers and Bible workers. This is the only way we use tithe money (we support ministers and Bible workers from this fund both in the United States and foreign countries).

Staff Medical Support Fund

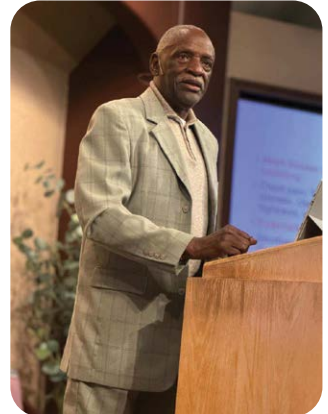
This fund helps us to partially reimburse our staff for large expenses resulting from sickness or accidents. Over the last 20 years, we have placed a small percentage from our general income into this fund monthly and it has grown to a relatively large sum. Although some of our staff have had large medical expenses, the Lord has blessed our staff with much better health than average. We do not want to use money from this fund to help pay our mission debt because this would place the ministry in financial jeopardy if one or more of our staff experienced a

catastrophic illness which happens both to God’s children and people of this world alike.

Because we have enough money in these other funds to cover our Mission fund deficit, we are solvent and can continue operating. We appreciate the sacrifice that our donors make in sending donations, but if most of our supporters could donate a few extra dollars for the mission fund, we could eventually retire this debt without having to stop any of our present mission outreach programs. These programs have been blessed by God in past years with hundreds of baptisms, but we believe that the Lord will increase His blessings on our mission work as we draw nearer the close of time. Where we see hundreds of baptisms today, we believe we will see thousands as a result of the latter rain that has been promised (Joel 2:23).

For nearly 40 years, the devil has worked with devious and determined purpose to shut down Steps to Life Ministries. Our God, who neither slumbers nor sleeps, has provided, blessed, and protected the work He has given us to do. And part of the way He has blessed us is through you. We could not fulfill the mission He has laid before us without your continuing support, both by prayer and donations.

Thank you. And may God bless each and every one of you as you continue to support His ministry.
